Information for Rosebery Hall residents

Rosebery Hall, 90 Rosebery Avenue, is located in Farringdon/Islington area of London, east of UCL. Please see the accompanying map for details. UCL can be reached either by walking or by taking the tube, both of which take a total time of about 25 minutes. The closest tube is Angel where there are also many shops, restaurants, cafes and pubs along St John Street (south of Angel) and Islington High Street and Upper Street (north of Angel).

Directions from UCL to Rosebery

Taking the tube

From UCL, walk to Euston station to catch the tube to Angel. You should take the Northern Line, but be careful to take the City Branch via Bank, soutbound train. Angel is two stops. Upon exiting the barriers as Angel, bear left and turn left out of the tube station and walk down Islington High Street. Follow the street over the traffic lights onto St John Street and keep walking straight down. The 2nd street on your right is Rosebery Avenue. Walk past Sadler's Wells theatre on your right and Rosebery Hall is on your left just after a small park.

The other closeish tube station is Farringdon, which is to the south of Rosebery Hall and also shown on the map. This has the advantage of being on the Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines, but is further to walk. From Farringdon station, you need to turn right, walk until Farringdon Road, where you again go right. You will eventually come to Rosebery Avenue, where you turn right and walk up to Rosebery Hall on the right-hand side.

Walking

From UCL main gates, turn left down Gower Street until the first street on your left, Torrington Place. Walk a little along here (the street name will change several times as there are several Squares) until you come to Bedford Way on your right. Walk to the end where you will meet Russell Square and turn left. Walk partly around Russell Square past Russell Hotel on your left and head down Guilford Street. Continue to the end, cross over Grays Inn Road and continue down Calthorpe Street. Again carry on along the continuation, Margery Street. Then take the 2nd street on your right, Wilmington Street. Take the first left along Merlin Street, which turns into Hardwick Street. At the end of Hardwick Street, is Rosebery Avenue and directly opposite Rosebery Hall. The walk is a pleasant walk through Bloomsbury with many beautiful houses and squares. For example the walk passes very close to Charles Dickens' House on Doughty Street, which is just off Guilford Street close to Grays Inn Road.
